Beginning Sabots/Cubes AM (Ages 8 and up)

This class is designed to teach the basics of sailing and to prepare your child to continue on to the next level. Sailors will learn how to rig and sail solo in a sabot or Cube, while learning about boat parts, wind direction, points of sail, cruising and the basics of racing.

Intermediate Sabots, BICs, Optimists (Ages 9 and up)

Sailors will learn advanced racing rules and tricks to improve boat speed in sabots **and** will have an opportunity to sail CFJs double-handed. This class is especially helpful for our sailors who wish to join high school/club teams and want some experience in racing both single-handed and double-handed boats. Students will be given the opportunity to participate in outside regattas with the full support of their coaches.
